#### **Full Class Meeting**

- Teachers will lead a live online meeting. In the meeting, they will:
  - Wrap up the morning work
  - Explain the student work expectations for the afternoon
  - Answer questions students might have
  - Some teachers will teach a math lesson live here; others will release students to watch a pre-recorded math lesson

- Students will participate in the live online meeting. In the meeting, they will:
  - Participate in the discussion wrapping up the morning
  - Receive their instruction for afternoon work
  - Ask teachers questions regarding afternoon work if they have any

# **Small Group Live Meetings Online**

- Teachers will have multiple <u>small group</u> live meetings online with students. In these meetings, teachers will be:
  - Teaching and supporting students around the learning of the day.
- Students will check into their Google Classroom for the lessons and assignments for the day. They will begin working independently on these assignments. The afternoon work could include:
  - Math
  - Science or Social Studies
  - iReady Math
- At an assigned time, students will join their teacher for their small group live online meeting.
- Some students may also meet with support staff during this time. For example, the Resource Room teacher, speech pathologist, EL teacher, paraprofessional/interventionist, etc.

\*\*\*We understand that not all students will be able to join the live full class meetings at 9:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. <u>Lessons will be recorded and shared with all students</u>. The main reasons for recording and sharing lessons are: 1) to support students who are unable to attend the live meeting; 2) in case students want to refer to them while working, even if they attended the live meeting.\*\*\*

Opportunities for specials classes—art, music, and physical education—will also be part of the weekly schedule.
